Duke, Charles Howard Candler Professor of Psychology at Emory University, is Editor in Chief of the *Journal of Family Life* and author of nine books and more than one hundred articles focusing on the family and other social learning networks. He is a member of the core faculty of Emory's Center for the Study of Myth and Ritual in American Life (MARIAL) and a Senior Faculty Fellow at Emory's Center for Ethics. Over the years, he has appeared on *Good Morning America*, the *Today Show*, and the *Oprah Winfrey Show*. His work has been written about in the *New York Times*, the *Boston Globe*, the *Wall Street Journal*, *Parents Magazine*, and *Time Magazine*.
